PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear students, parents and teachers,

Just a reminder that our **Staff Development Day for Term 3 will be held on Monday 1**st **September**. This will be a pupil free day and the teachers will be involved in professional development involving the new English and Mathematics Syllabus documents.

This week our Year 6 students participated in the **Voice of Youth** Finals for our Holroyd cluster. Congratulations to our School Captain, **Olivia Pratt**, who took first place in the competition and **Annie Azzi**, who received the Social Justice Award. Making a convincing speech in front of 500 fellow students is a difficult task and we were all very proud of their efforts.

Last week our Year 6 students travelled to Canberra for an overnight excursion. It was a great opport unity to experience, first-hand, the history and government workings of our nation's capital. All of the children represented their school with pride and several comments were made by the public about how well they conducted themselves. The experience has allowed for lots of very interesting discussion and real learning on this important topic.

On Monday 8th September we will be having a **Special Mass** for **Mary** on the feast of her birthday. The Mass will involve our whole community – parishioners, OLQP Primary students, St. Paul's College students and OLQP Pre-School children. Weather permitting, it will be held on the **oval at St. Paul's** at **11.00am**. The Mass will begin with a procession of Kinder, Year 1 and 2 students along with the statue of Mary. They will pray together with us and will then return to their classes. This is the first time our whole community has come together to celebrate Mass so it would be great to see lots of parents on the day.
