Next term there will be a significant change in how we use our newsletter. The school newsletter will be a one page editorial about present and upcoming events. All other information regarding Religious Education, canteen news, sports information etc will be available on our website under "Latest News" and "Announcements". Browsing the website will allow you to be informed about general information from the school. Skoolbag will remain in use

for significant events and reminders.

Just a reminder about dismissal in the afternoon. The gates to the playground will not be open before 3.00pm. Parents are asked not to enter the school before 3.00pm as it does interfere with sport and other activities. For the sake of easier movement, parents are asked to enter and leave the school from the gate near Year 5 and not through the Blue Room.

Our next two staff development (pupil free) days will be June 18th and 7th of September. These are professional learning days for the teachers.
