Dear Parents, Students and Teachers.

Our celebration of Catholic Schools Week began on Monday with a wonderful liturgy involving teachers, students and ex-students. We then opened the classrooms and lots of parents were able to attend our first COOL

School event. On Tuesday we were visited by a world renowned educator from Canada - Mrs Lyn Sharratt. She also visited our classrooms and gave some great feedback to our teachers about how learning is organised for our students. Yesterday we had Open Day for our prospective Kinder parents for 2019. Parents were very impressed by the great work happening in Kindergarten.

Last year the P&F agreed that some work needs to be done in the area of anxiety and resilience and our first parent workshop will focus on this topic. Warren Hopley will be speaking to us on Tuesday 27th March at 7.00pm in the library. Warren has worked extensively in this area and spoke to the P&F three years ago on Boys Learning. This talk sparked a change of thinking around our playground spaces and we hope to have the same change in thinking around building resilience in our children.

You may have noticed that our last newsletter was sent out yesterday instead of last week. A similar problem occurred with our school fees invoice distribution. These are automated systems which obviously did not work correctly but have now been rectified. Our apologies for any inconvenience.

The School Dentist will be onsite from Monday to Friday next week. This is an excellent service available to all

The main entry gate on Braeside Road has been locked recently for added security. A release buzzer has been installed toward the top the gate for parents to be able to exit more easily.

Cumberland Council Rangers were in attendance during the week and there were some concerns about parents queuing along the Kiss and Ride zone. I have approached Council about the appropriate signage along this area and if it needs to be changed. In the meantime it is important that we observe the road rules particularly children wearing seat belts, not double parking and not parking across driveways. If we do not use our system as it is intended then the Council has the right to remove it.

We have had an issue recently with students messaging their parents from school using their devices. It is not appropriate for students to message their parents at any time. Students can contact their parents through the office if they need assistance. Mobile phones also need to be submitted to the office each morning before class.

We have had a great response to our Facebook Page. Thank you to everyone who has sent messages of encouragement and affirmation. We will continue to use Facebook to communicate the great work being done in our classrooms.
