FORGET PASSWORD UPDATE! IMPORTANT QKR UPDATE

FOR YOUR INFORMATION: Masterpass Support Centre

Schools had previously been advised to direct Qkr users/parents at their school who had Qkr login issues and could not reset their password to contact the Masterpass Support Centre by calling 1800 689 562.

Qkr users with login issues or password reset issues should no longer be advised to call the Masterpass Support Centre.

Instead, it is recommended that you provide your Qkr account manager (Kim Farrugia via the Canteen email (<u>olqpgreystanescanteen@gmail.com</u>) with the following details:

· User's email address on Qkr

· User's mobile phone number on Qkr

 \cdot The first name and surname of one or more of the user's children

This will enable your Qkr account manager to confirm and delete the user's Qkr registration so that the user can then Sign Up on Qkr using the same email and mobile phone number if desired.

Note that deleting the user's Qkr registration will also delete their access to their previous Qkr receipts. Users will, however, be able to see their Qkr purchase transactions on their credit card statement, and the school will be able to verify their transaction details if required by generating a Store Manager transaction report.To avoid the possibility of users losing access to their Qkr receipts in future, they can activate the option to Always Email Receipts on their Qkr app settings.
