Class teachers can provide a more comprehensive picture of your child's overall progress and this will be discussed with you at the end of next term at the half yearly interviews.

This week we had our first session of Coffee and Chat with Anne Hines. Anne is the Parish Pastoral Coordinator (Life in Faith Enrichment).
